August 11, 2023: In just under a year since their formation, the Brisbane-based Americana/Indie-folk duo **Minor Gold** (Tracy McNeil & Dan Parsons) have been moving at a rapid pace. Since the release of their melodic debut single *Mona Lisa* last October, what followed was a whirlwind start to the year which saw the duo perform at Folk Alliance (Kansas), a debut performance at Port Fairy Folk Festival & a 17-date Australian tour. The release of two more singles, *Way With Words* & *Don't Change*, saw

them pick up high rotation around the country (along with *Mona Lisa*) on Double J, ABC Local, ABC Country and community radio.

Minor Gold captures the duo at their finest, weaving masterful harmonies around stripped-back, organic arrangements that draw on everything from 70's west-coast pop and Bleecker St. steeped folk to the ballad-power and polaroid romance of the 80's. Through this superb collection of songs, Minor Gold display a spellbinding musical connection, reflecting the comfort and ease experienced as the album washes over you.

Written in and around lock-downs, the 10 songs find McNeil and Parsons in a largely contemplative, escapist mindset. "A lot of these lyrics stemmed from a subconscious place of wanting to be somewhere else – both physically and mentally" says McNeil. "As the songs would come through, we'd look back occasionally and realise that themes of dreaming, leaving and traveling were constant through-lines. In many forms, Escapism seemed to be the common thread."

Recorded in Brisbane by longtime friend Hugh Middleton, the result is a glorious Trans-Pacific 'Americana' sound: Album opener "Mona Lisa" sets the tone with its gorgeous slow-burn intensity as it showcases McNeil and Parsons' 2mesmerizing harmonies and their uncanny, near telepathic ability to distill their voices into one. "Way With Words" rides a lazy, sunny groove; irresistible in its well-worn country-soul leanings, finding itself somewhere between Bonnie & Delaney and The Teskey Brothers. The duo sing of a certain character leaving behind their earthly distractions for a metaphorical life in orbit on 'Cannonball' — a stunning example of the restrained camp-fire intensity on which Minor Gold have made their reputation.

Minor Gold's much-anticipated debut album is out today and sees the duo celebrating its release (& a sold out show in Seattle) whilst on an extensive 3-month tour in North America. With 26 shows booked, including four US shows supporting The Teskey Brothers, performances at this year's AMERICANAFEST and a soon to be announced Australian Tour, Minor Gold is becoming a major thing!
